An extract of a letter from Northampton, dated Nov. 12, 1805.

"A most barbarous murder was committed our Saturday the 9th inft. on one Marcus Lyon, of Woodstock, as he was journeying through Wilbraham, in the county of Hampihire. The body was throwninto Chicabee river, which was near the road, and flones were thrown upon it. The coroner's inquefe find that he was shot with a pistol bell, and his shulls was beaten and broken to pieces by a piftol and cifibs... The murderers are supposed to be two transient perfons, who have proceeded into Connecticut. I amy informed that a number of perfons have gone in perfuit of them."

Obediah Williams, alias J. W. Thompson, for some time confined in prison at Baltimore, for various offences and condemned to fuffer death on the 8th inflant, wasbrought, under the gallows before an immense concourfes of people, who had affembled on the occasion : but as few minutes before he was to be launched into eternityan order arrived from the governor, commuting his punissiment to 15 years nard labor on the roads.

We observe that the " Bois," in copying the Georgia: Land Claimants' flatement, has given the introductory: observations as editorial. This is not correct, as we have given no opinion upon the fubject; but merely; opened our columns to their defence, that the public may fee on what ground they reft.
