To Ebenezer Mattoon Esq. Sheriff of the County
of Hampshire — Greeting

Whereas Dominick Daley and James
Halligan late residents in Boston labourers
were before the Justices of our Supreme
Judicial Court holden at Northampton
in ^{the} County of Hampshire, were convicted
of the crime of Murder committed on the
body of one Marcus Lyon, and thereupon
by our said Justices, were sentenced to suffer
the pains of Death, as to this appears of record,
an exemplification of which is hereunto an-
nexed, whereof execution remains to be done.

We therefore, by and with the advice of Our Council,
pursuant to the Statute for such case made and provided,
command you, that on ~~the~~ Thursday the fifth day of
June next, between the hours of twelve and three of
the Clock, in the day time, at the usual place of Execution,
you cause execution on the persons of the said Dominick
Daley and James Halligan, to be done and performed in
all things according to the form and effect of the said
Judgment and sentence, for which this shall be your
sufficient Warrant — Hence fail not at your peril,
and make return of this Writ, with your doings herein,
into ~~the~~ Our Secretary's Office, within thirty days after
the time expressed for its fulfilment.
