Again in 1862 the natives were beginning to find fault with the dike which enclosed Maple and Fruit streets. This, of course, was a periodic complaint which returned again and again, particularly after freshets or predictions of flooding.

An ugly gap had been discovered some time before, but had been let go until November when the situation became more irritating than ever.

On Nov. 25 there appeared in the Gazette a very strange story relative to the dike and the gap men-
tion.

"It will be remembered by many of the old Irish inhabitants of the town that Daley and Halligan were executed for the murder of Marcus Lyon.

"Their bodies were dissected in the Dickinson House on Maple Street. The flesh was boiled from the bones in the old slaughter house then standing on the lot in the rear of Alfred Adams' place near South Street bridge.

"Workmen now digging up earth to repair the dike have dug up the brick work on which rested the kettle used on the occasion."
