Whereas on the ninth day of Nov

November instant, at Wilbraham in the County of Hampshire, a horrid murder was committed on one Marcus Lyon who was there traveling on the highway and it is presumed that divers valuable articles were then and there feloniously taken from the said Lyon.

I do hereby, in behalf of the Commonwealth, offer a reward of five hundred Dollars to any person or persons who shall apprehend the murder or murderers, and prosecute him or them, until he or they shall be convicted of the said murder.
