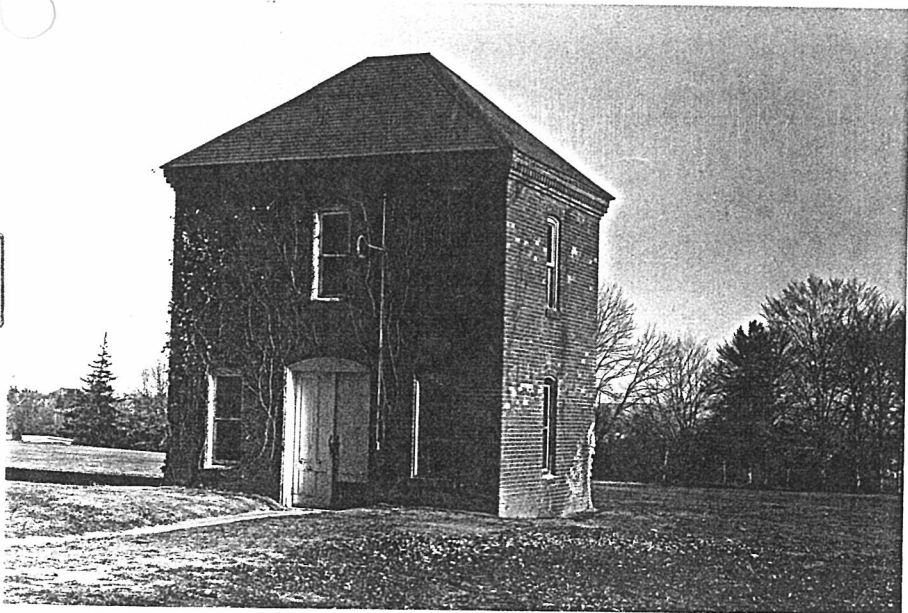

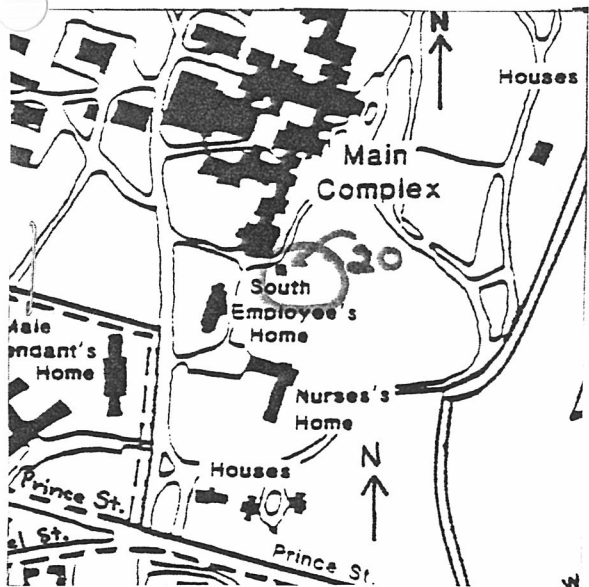

8. Historical significance.

The greenhouse was "designed to make use of the later and improved ideas in construction and heating". Built in 1890-91 the structure was 20' wide and 100' long, with a two-story, 20' square brick addition.

In 1980 the greenhouse portion was demolished. leaving only the brick addition.
