ORDINANCE AND BYE-LAWS, FOR THE REGULATION OF THE Bank of the United States.

At a general meeting of the Stockholders of the Bank of the United States, held at the City-Hall, in Philadelphia, on Monday evening, October 31, 1791...

MR. BINGHAM, from the committee appointed to examine the petition of the Bank of the United States...

Sec. I. That the bank shall be opened for the transaction of business, every day in the year...

Sec. VI. That the bank shall receive all specie coins, according to the rates and value that have been or shall hereafter be established by Congress.

Sec. X. That in case the board of directors shall at any time make a dividend exceeding the profits of the bank...

Sec. XIV. That the board of directors are hereby authorized and empowered to fix and establish...

Sec. XV. That the board of directors are hereby authorized and empowered to establish a common seal, with suitable devices...

Sec. XVII. That the board of directors are hereby authorized to let out or hire for a term not exceeding two years...

Sec. XVIII. That in case it shall happen that an election of directors shall not be made at a meeting of the stockholders...
