

the revolution supposes; it is no where exists; and over the principles are upon which a nation has found its Constitution, and the nearer they approach real liberty, the more it is inclined to re-pel every propensity of such a division of one of the original constituents of its sovereignty.

It is true that different capitulations and treaties with the Days and deports of the states of *Passey*, and the parts of the *Leaves*, suppose that trials between Frenchmen may be determined by *Confid*; but those absolute Princes, who judge over the lives and fortunes of their subjects, and laws, especially to themselves, that the judicial authority of their tribunals, may follow them wherever they go, into whatever country they transport their dominions, and from reciprocity they dispossess themselves whenever the cause of a foreigner is in question; but little jealous of the exclusive exercise of this noble attribute of sovereign power, often fatigued with the plenitude of their authority, they, without regret, suffer a few particles of dispositions of their conventions and treaties, and demand the execution of them as often as convenience may require it. They prevent the tribunes of commerce from pronouncing slightly upon controversies, upon a pretense that indemnities may be exacted in cases where a wrong decision may take place. In fact, they maintain a fineness in judgments and more particularly in every thing which may interest the neutrality of powers not engaged in the war, or commit it in open hostility to them.

The Commissaries of the Executive power, most of the tribunals, are also provided, by the ministry of justice, with trials of all conventions and treaties of commerce and neutrality with foreign powers, often fatigued with the plenitude of their authority, they, without regret, suffer a few particles of dispositions of their conventions and treaties, and demand the execution of them as often as convenience may require it.

They prevent the tribunes of commerce from pronouncing slightly upon controversies, upon a pretense that indemnities may be exacted in cases where a wrong decision may take place.

In fact, they maintain a fineness in judgments and more particularly in every thing which may interest the neutrality of powers not engaged in the war, or commit it in open hostility to them.

They do not examine whether the principles of neutrality proclaimed with much solemnity by *Russia*, and received with so much acclamation by all commercial nations (except *England*) have not experienced formidable attacks in the course of the present war. It is sufficient for us that they are still, for us to profit in supporting them, we will bring them to their nations, without their perhaps reciprocal, though transient, assistance away from them; they will then not partake in the burden of the war, but will be compelled that it is their duty, as well as their interest, to take measures to cause their neutrality to be respected.

In fact, our ministers, by instructions which shall soon be given, will seek the execution of the law, the end of which is submitted to the Council of Admiralty.

We have full sufficient, Colleagues, in peace,

if it is adopted to prevent encroachments,

and is only the summa-

ry of a code which is yet incomplete; it will re-

move every thing which may relate to trials by spe-

cial commission, in them without

exception to equity on one part, or a ceremony which

is indispensable on the other, and prevent trials

and encroachments in the mutual of different elec-

tions; but perhaps some care was

designed them in this behalf, a portion of its in-

stitution, you cannot, my colleague, doubt man-

fully at the same time desirous I anticipated

in open ports.

I submit to the dispute, should we for the Bi-

ritish *Confid* sparingly pronouncing upon, dif-

charge and release the prize, and even propose

with a secret joy, the seeds of rupture or diffi-

culty between us and the nation whose citizens or subjects should conceive themselves aggrieved? In

fact, a neutral nation can never be a helpless power,

ought not to suffer either of them to exercise

its power at an *adversary* even towards its

enemy; it is itself exposed itself to indemnifica-

tion, and to war, if it has not been able to prove

this violation of its neutrality, and in this case, of
