Jonathan Strong had this brick residence built in 1862 on land of the Strong Family. Calvin Strong owned the earlier residence, corner of South and Fort Streets, and sold the land to the northeast to J. Strong in 1862. The new brick structure was hailed by the Hampshire Gazette as "one of the finest dwellings" on South Street. At the time of its construction, brick was scarce in the area, the Civil War and local conditions limiting production.

The bracketed style is two stories in height, five bays wide and two deep. A deep bracketed overhang terminates the cubic mass now enlarged by bay windows and an entrance porch in similar style. In its massing, if not in its decorative elements, the structure is related to the adjacent Calvin Strong House, a rederal style dwelling. The architect of the Jonathan Strong House remains a mystery.
