

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE (describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within community)

This two-and-a-half story clapboard house features decorative shingles in the front gable, carved bargeboards and pendant, a one-story bay window on the eastern side and an ornate front porch. The porch is one story in height with a shed roof, chamfered posts, cut-out brackets and an elaborate cut-out pattern balustrade.
