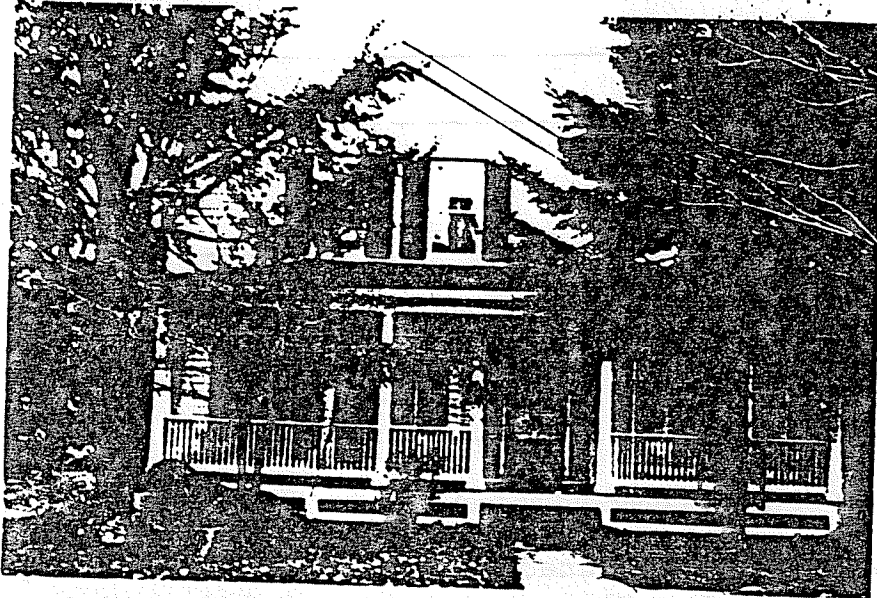

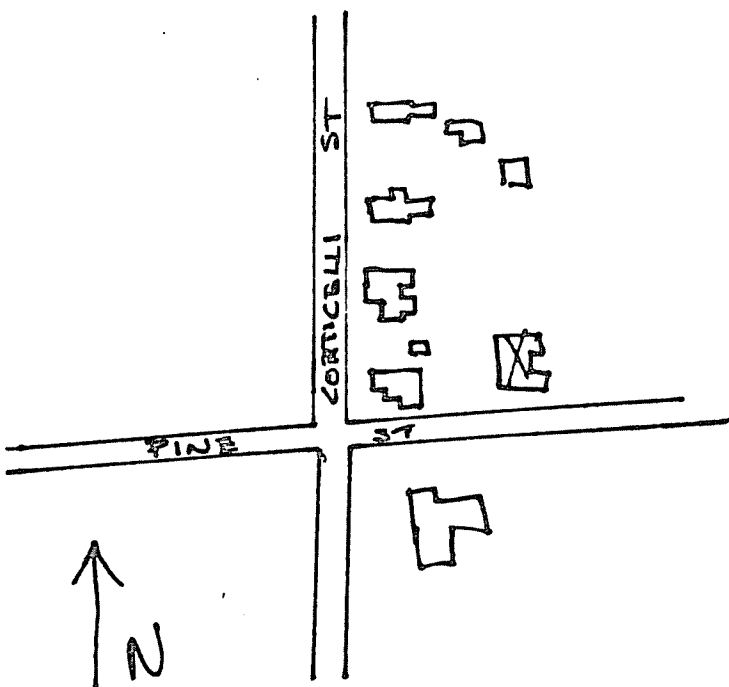

This compact, 1½ story residence is located on the road to the lower bridge crossing in Florence. It predates Florence's rise to industrial prominence, and probably predates Florence itself, as that name was given to this general area in the early 1850's when the Post Office was established.
