"Village Lots", with buildings and other improvements for \$1000. A simple one-and-a-half story cottage with gable end to the street and entrance on the southern side is shown in the 1895 <u>History of Florence</u>. This was transformed into the present structure within the next few years. Henry Haven, who had bought the property from the hiers of William Haven in 1870, but lived on the other side of Park St., is listed at this house in the 1900 directory. The remodeling was done to reflect his position as the surer and general manager of the Florence Furniture Co.
