

Mr Goodwin had filed a subdivision plan in 1868 for the area between Locust and South Main Sts. bounded easterly by the terrace drop-off into the meadows of Broughton Brook. Mr. Rindge's house was built immediately as it is shown on the 1873 atlas, and he is listed at this address in the 1873 directory, which also describes him as a machinist.
