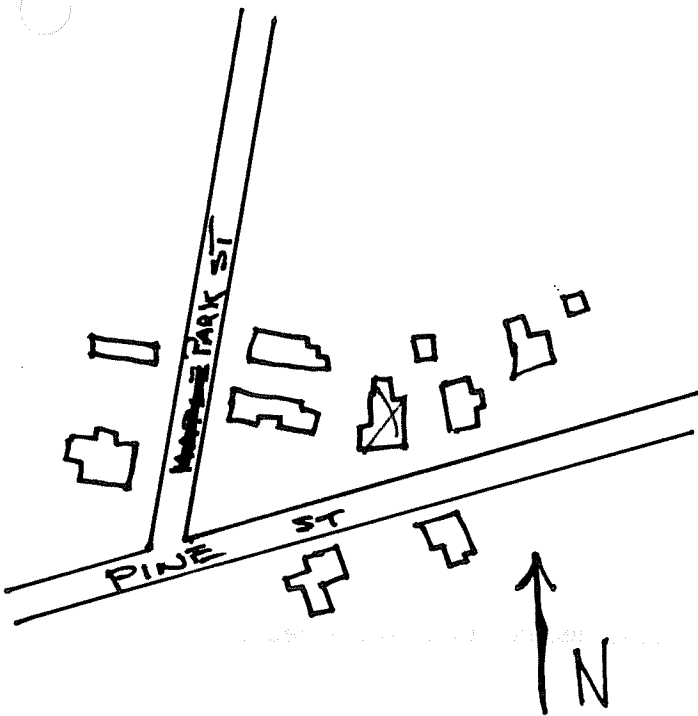

This two-and-a-half story "Bracketed" residence is one of several built along Pine St. in the latter part of the 19th century. It features a front porch with slender posts on pedestals and elaborately carved brackets, and a bracketed frieze under the raking cornices of the house's gables. Small modillions support the raking hoods of the second floor windows.
