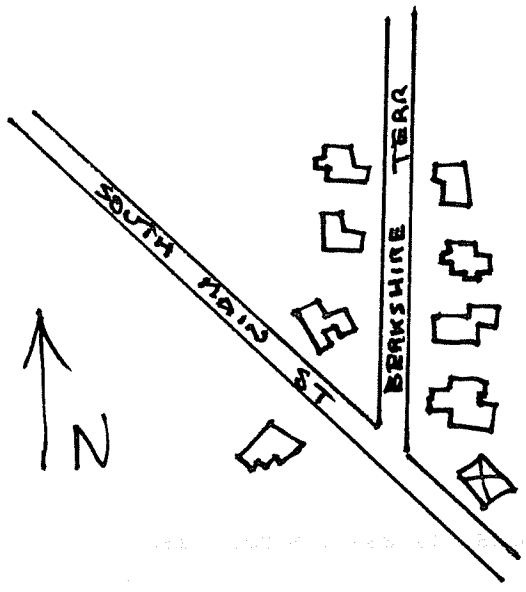

9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

This is one of the more recent houses built along South Main St. in Florence. Most of the other houses date from the last third of the 19th century. The smooth stucco finish and relative overall symmetry contrast with the clapboard, decorative shingles and asymmetry of the Victorian houses.

The house is two-and-a-half stories in height with a three-bay facade and a one-story sun porch on the eastern end.
