

This Large, two-and-a-half story residence is prominently located at the junction of three important mid-nineteenth century roads: the road leading to the Bay State mills (Riverside Drive), the road to Warner's Silk Mill (Federal Street heading north), and the road to the Paper Mill (Federal Street heading south). For some unknown reason, this lot wasn't developed until the early twentieth century.

The house is two-and-a-half stories in height with slate, hipped roof and has projecting, pedimented gables at the southwest and northeast corners. A one story porch extends between these two projecting gables. The porch has turned posts with fancy brackets and a balustrade with turned balusters.
