



This large clapboard house was built on land of Richard O'Brien.

Mr. O'Brien, a mason, bought a little more than an acre of land on the eastern slope of Baker's Hill, fronting on Hinckley St., for \$29^.75 in 1869. The sale was made subject to a right of way 33 feet wide "in continuation of road already located south of premises". This was Maple St. (now Maplewood Terrace). Mr. O'Brien's house was located west of the proposed street. Shortly before 1895, this house was buil\* east of Maple St., fronting on Hinckley St.

The house is two and a half stories in height, gable end to the street, with a large cross gable to the southern side. Decoratively cut shingles are used in the gables and ornate porches with turned posts, fancy brackets and balustrades cover the two sections of the facade.
