It is two stories tall with slate hipped roof and has a two story bay window with polygonal roof at the northern end of the facade. The southern end of the facade is angled to provide another bay window, and is also capped by a polygon roof. A one-story porch covers half of the facade and extends slightly along the southern side of the house. This porch has a flat roof with projecting comice, pedimented entrance, Tuscan columns, balustrade and lattice base.
