

This is basically a rowhouse with three units. Two stories in height with a slate hipped roof, the block has three two-and-a-half story, gabled projections on the State St. side and a wall gable on the Elm St. side. Each of these gables has a small "Gothic" window within and two-story bay windows. On State St. two story porches extend between the bays, sheltering the recessed entrances.
