East Center St. is part of the 1870's subdivision that Nonotuck Silk Co. developed atop the hill northeast of the village of Leeds. By 1884 six houses had been built on this street, including this one, which was listed as belonging to Frederick Yeatman, a carpenter with the Mill River Button Co., one of Leeds's main businesses.

The house is L-shaped, 2½ stories in height and has a rear ell. A one-story porch with bracketed cornice, posts and a low balustrade is in the crook of the L. A tall chimney stack caps the ridge of the slate, by coof and small round-headed windows are set within the gables.
