The exterior wall surface is stuccoed; small stones are used in the foundation as in the porch. The projecting caves reveal framing and elaborate on the variety of materials revealed in the design. Interiors are finished in dark wood; columns in the living area echo those on the porch. A garage incorporated into the original design is located in the rear.
