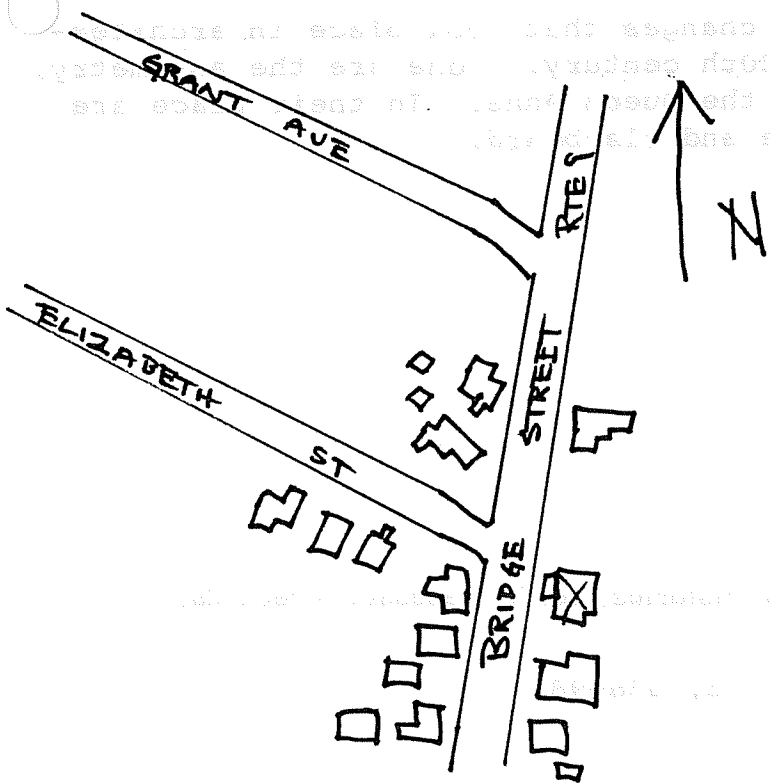

9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

The house is two stories in height, with high hip roof and is crowned by ornate iron cresting. A one-story, hipped-roof porch covers two of the three bays of the facade, and has fluted, square posts and a balustrade. The central entrance is flanked by two over-sized front windows.

This house exhibits the changes that took place in architectural style at the beginning of the 20th century. Gone are the asymmetry, towers, bays, and mixed materials of the Queen Anne. In their place are symmetry, and broad expanses of slate and clapboard.
