Round Hill. It quickly became one of the most fashionable street to build upon in the city. Development was mostly during the first third of the 20th century. This corner house was built during the mid 1920's and is an interesting example of a double house within the Bungalow mode. In 1930 James Abbott, a salesman for Packard, Hudson and Essex Moter Cars at McGrannis Moter Sales on King St., and Herbert Loomis, director of Smith's Agricultural School, were listed at this address.
