The house is two stories high with high, slate, hipped roof. Projecting rafters are visible under the slightly flared roof. Two-story bay windows capped by projecting gables are at the northeast corner of the facade and the southern corner of the western side. Within the gables are diamond paned "Palladian" windows. A one-story porch with hipped roof, gable entrance, doubled, fluted posts and balustrade streches between the two bays. The main entrance has wide, leaded sidelights.
