AUTER DE L'A

Kensington Ave. was opened up in 1890 through the Aaron Breck homstead on Elm St. The street was quickly developed and became one of the most "aristocratic" of city streets. This house was built for Myron Elmer, a driver for the Smith Carr Baking Co. Mr. Elmer is first listed here in the 1894-95 directory.

The house is  $2\frac{1}{2}$  stories tall with gable and to the street and a two-story tower with flaring pyramidal roof on the eastern side. The house is very narrow with the one-bay facade being covered by a one-story porch with turned posts, brakcets and patterned balustrade. The porch also extends slightly along the eastern side to the tower, which contains the main entrance. An oriel window with polygonal roof is on the second story of the facade.
