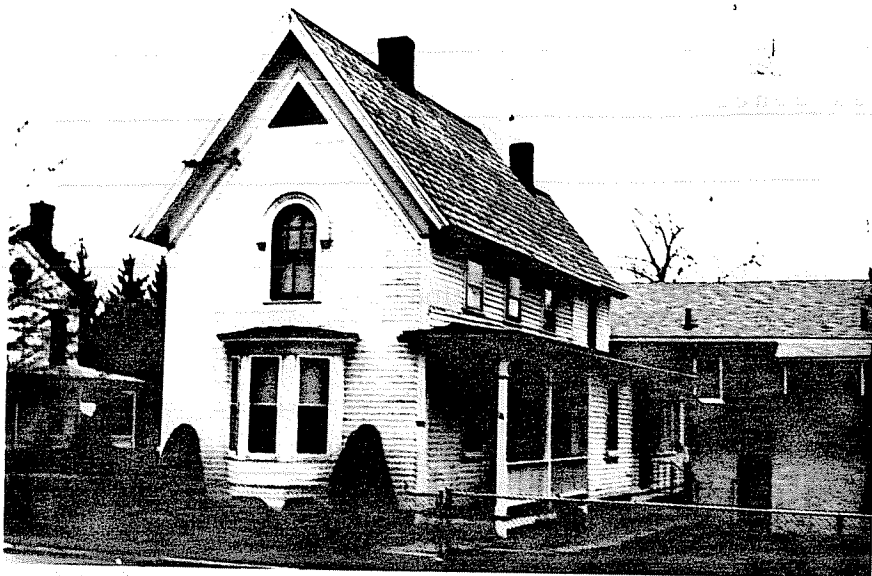

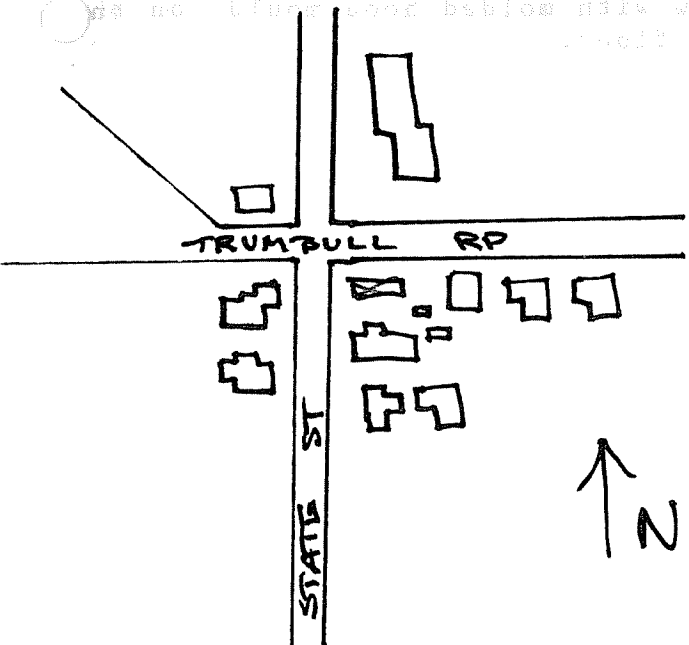

This small, one-and-a-half story cottage has a steeply-pitched, slate roof with gable end to the street. The entrance is located on the southern side and is covered by a one-story hipped roof porch with arched opening between the chamfered piers and a balustrade. The State St. end has a round-headed six over two sash window with molded hood mould on the second floor and a bay window on the first floor.
