


in the United States to Birdseye Northrop. Like Edward Gillett, Birdseye Northrop was named in Sophia Smith's will as one of the original trustees of Smith College. He served in this position from 1871-1898.

Northrop House is identical to Gillett House in elvation, style, ar materials, except that the "L" shaped plan is reversed.
