

Architectural Significance

"three over three" pattern, in which each second floor window is aligned with a matching opening at the first floor level. The Main entryway, fanlit with flanking sidelights and pilassers, is supported by white Doric fluted columns. A second story room was later added above the porch roof. Two other side porches (east-service, west-formal) were added at a later date. A polygenal bay window which projects from the west side of the parlor interrupts the taut rectilinear massing of the rest of the house.
