

This uniquely designed residential building occupies a prominent corner site at State St. and Bedford Terrace. It was built in 1900 as "Mrs. Pomeroys Residence for ContegeGirls" at a cost of \$23,000. It has been well maintained and provides a bit of visual contrast to the Colonial Revival houses on Bedford Terrace, and small commercial buildings on this end of State St.

In the 1900 directory Elizabeth Pomeroy and her husband Charles lived next door to this site at 32 Bedford Terrace. However, by 1905, her husband had died and Mrs. Pomeroy was living in this block.
