

The house is two-and-a-half stories tall with diamond-pattern, slate, ridge roof and two interior chimneys. The five-bay facade has a double central entrance and is covered by a porch with low-pitched hipped roof, projecting cornice, square posts and a balustrade. Above the entrance are two narrow four over four sash windows. The other windows in the house have six over six sashes.
