This L-shaped house was built between 1860 and 1873. Two stories in height, the house is decorated with large cut-out brackets under the wide eaves. The windows have segmented hoods with small brackets, and brackets are also used under the porch's cornice. The porch is one story high and wraps around the facade to the cross gable on the southern side. Besides the brackets the porch also has turned posts and a balustrade of closely-spaced square balusters. Small, louvered "Gothic" windows are in each gable.
