The house is two-and-a-half stories in height with gables to the sides and one-story wells on eitherside. The facade has a central entrance with double doorway and entry porch with turned posts, brackets and side balustrade. This is flanked by a one-story bay window on either side and has two round-headed windows with hood-moulds above it on the second floor. Double brackets are under the raking cornice on the front and sides. There are also porches on either side of the house, beginning at the corners of the facade, and extending back to, and then along the ells. These porches are composed of the same elements as the front entry porch.
